

MOCRA SUMMER CRUISE 2006

l'le de Brehat to Morlaix

5th - 13th August

In 2006 we plan to re-instate our plans to visit l'le de Brehat and a section of the north Brittany coastline as far as Morlaix. We will converge on Lezardrieux so that members can regroup from the cruise across the channel and agree final passage plans. The main aim of this cruise will be to dry out for a day or two on the island of Brehat, an island only 1 mile wide by 2 miles across, the largest of many found at the entrance of the Trieux River. It is in reality two islands connected by a narrow isthmus. It boasts tropical plants such as mimosa, pink coloured rocks, no cars, pine woods, sandy coves and a good fish restaurant! The remainder of the week will be sailing west along the French coast where we hope to visit Treguier, Ploumanach, Morlaix and other smaller harbours along the way.

As usual final details will be agreed with those boats attending. Please note that last minute changes may be necessary due to weather so please keep in contact, by phone or email, with Mike Millerchip (Cruising Secretary) before you depart. Underway we will use VHF and mobile phones. It is normal to try and arrange for boats from the same sailing areas to try and meet before they leave and sail in company, especially for the trip over the channel. It's a good opportunity to build experience of offshore passage planning and, once across, visit more out of the way anchorages or harbours and of course meet other multihull owners.
